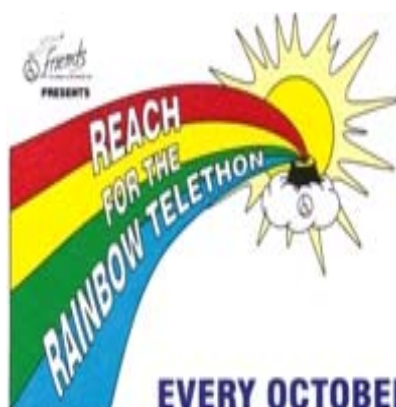
## SPOTLIGHT ON...

Tammy Logan— Information Officer



The Sunshine Coach provides transportation for people in Renfrew and area who are living with disabilities that render the use of conventional modes of public transportation inappropriate to their needs. The Sunshine Coach service operates as a community organization under the umbrella of the non-profit registered charitable organization chartered as Friends of the Disabled (Renfrew) Inc. The service was initiated in March of 1985 for persons who because of mobility impairments are unable to board regular public transit with dignity. The day to day operations of the service is the responsibility of the members of **Friends of the Disabled (Renfrew) Inc.** a charitable non-profit volunteer organization whose basic objective is to provide programs and services for persons coping with disabilities and improve their opportunity to become integrated into the community and enhance their quality of life.

Since 2005 the *Renfrew and Area Chamber of Commerce* has been donating funds from their golf tournaments and golf series to the Sunshine Coach. We are happy to be doing so again this year. We welcome you to join us in supporting this valuable resource to our community.
