For those of us who had the opportunity to meet and greet the Renfrewshire folk, we also had the indulgence of eating ‘Maple Sugar Cookies’ baked by Renfrew Council Member, Gail Cole. I know Gail has had numerous request for her recipe and she has generously agreed to share with us.

### MAPLE SUGAR COOKIES

2/3 cup softened butter 2 tsp ground cinnamon

¾ cup granulated sugar 2 cups all purpose flour

1 egg 1 ½ tsp baking powder

4 tsp maple syrup ½ tsp salt

1 tsp vanilla extract

In a large bowl, with mixer at medium speed, cream butter and sugar until light and fluffy.

Beat in egg, maple syrup and vanilla. Blend in cinnamon, flour, baking powder and salt until well mixed.

Divide dough in half and chill for ½ hour. Heat oven to 325.

Grease large cookie sheets. On a lightly floured surface, working with ½ of the dough at a time, roll 1/8 inch thick. Dip cookie cutter into flour and cut into desired shapes.

Using a metal spatula, place cookies ½ inch apart on cookie sheets. Reroll trimmings and continue to cut shapes.

Bake 8 minutes or until very lightly browned. Transfer cookies to racks to completely cool.

Sprinkle with maple sugar. Makes about 3 dozen cookies

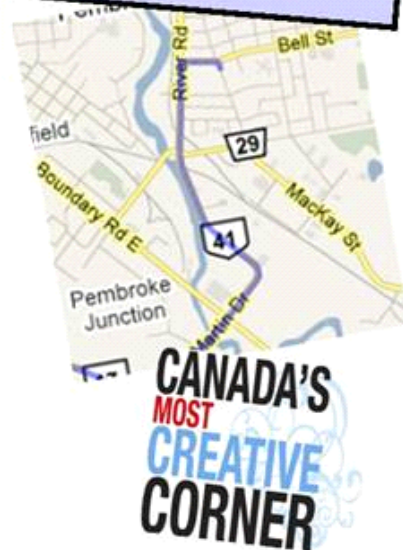
